- serve as an official spokesperson on behalf of the team
- coordinate the delegation of responsibilities to the Assistant Coach(es) and Manager
- plan on-ice and off-ice team activities in consultation with the Assistant Coach(es) and trainer
- coordinate player evaluation and player selection in conjunction with the Division Director.
- plan, implement and control pre-game preparation and communication with the team
- design the practice plans with assistance from the Assistant Coach(es)
- coach the Team in all games and practices
- establish rules for the team and oversee the supervision of the players
- submit a mid-season report and year-end report which contains the following information: evaluation of the players' performance, evaluation of the team's performance, outline of practice plans and game strategy and recommendations on how the program can be improved, and summary of accomplishments
- coordinate the implementation of the on-ice and off-ice curriculum as outlined
